OPEN SWIM DESCRIPTIONS:

Parent & Tot Swim

• Max. Age for Tot is 6 years old.

Parent & Child Swim

Maximum 3 kids per adult.

Adult must accompany children in water
For children 17 years or younger with an adult

• For children 1 Adult Swim

- Must be over 18
- Open Swim

All Ages

Lap Swim

Membership is needed \$25/month or \$42/3month

Pool Rules & Regulations

- 1. Obey the lifeguards and follow pool rules. They are there for your safety.
- 2. All persons are required to shower before entering the pool area.
- 3. Food and drink are not permitted in the pool area.
- 4. No smoking allowed in the pool area.
- 5. Clean swimwear is required.
- 6. No running allowed on pool deck.

7. Only clean footwear or wheelchairs are allowed in the pool area. Persons in street clothes and street shoes are not allowed on the pool deck.

8. Persons with open wounds, excessive sunburn, abrasions that have not healed, or bandages of any kind cannot be allowed in the water.

- 9. Except during Park District classes, SCUBA gear is not allowed in the pool.
- 10. No flotation devices may be used in the pool, unless US Coast Guard Approved Flotation Device.
- 11. Family Swim Parents/Guardians must accompany children in the water.
- 12. Children 8 and under, who are not at least 8" taller than the shallow end must be accompanied by an adult.
