Airport Support in Tokyo

Haneda Airport (HND) & Narita Airport (NRT)

Turkish Airlines also operates **airport sales/service desks** at Tokyo's major international airports:

Haneda Airport (Tokyo International Airport) – airline counters open daily for check-in and travel day assistance. (www.airofficesguides.com)

Narita International Airport (NRT) – longer-haul flights often depart from here, and service counters assist on departure/arrival. (WhereAirlinesFly)

Airport staff can help with:

- Flight day **check-in & boarding passes**
- Baggage drop & excess baggage queries
- Flight status & departure gate information
- Last-minute itinerary changes (where permitted)

For airport service desk inquiries, calling the local Turkish Airlines customer support is often the best first step as official direct airport desk numbers vary by terminal and flight schedules. (www.airofficesguides.com)

Tips for Travelers in Tokyo

- **Call ahead before going:** Office is typically open on weekdays only and closed on weekends/public holidays. (airlinesofficedesk.com)
