

The 2026 Guide: How Early to Book Frontier International Flights

1. The "Goldilocks Window" for International Fares

For international routes (e.g., Orlando to Cancun or Philadelphia to San Juan), the best prices typically appear **3 to 5 months** before departure.

- **Why wait?** Unlike major carriers that open bookings 330 days out, Frontier often launches international schedules only **6 to 9 months** in advance. If you look too early, you may not see any flights listed at all.
- **The Price Drop:** Fares often start high when a new schedule is first released, drop significantly during the "sweet spot" (90–150 days out), and then skyrocket in the final **21 days**.
- **Live Updates:** If your desired dates aren't showing on the calendar, call = +1 ↗ (US) or ☎ [ {1 877 622 0707} (USA) or ☎ [ {1 877 622 0707} (USA) ☎ (US) to find out when the next schedule extension is expected.

2. Booking for Peak vs. Shoulder Seasons

The "how early" rule changes based on when you plan to fly.

Season	Best Time to Book	Why?
Peak (Spring Break, Christmas)	6+ Months Out	International seats are limited; these sell out fast.
Shoulder (Sept–Nov, Jan–Feb)	1–3 Months Out	Deep discounts often appear last-minute to fill seats.
New Route Launch	Immediately	Intro fares as low as \$79–\$99 are usually "book it now" prices.

3. The GoWild! Pass International Rules

For 2026 GoWild! Pass holders, the booking window is strictly regulated:

- **Standard Window:** You can book and confirm international flights starting **10 days before** departure.¹
- **The Risk:** Seats are capacity-controlled.² If you wait until the 10-day mark for a popular route like Cancun, there may be no GoWild! seats left.

- **Early Booking:** Frontier now allows pass holders to "lock in" select international flights earlier for a small fee.³ To see if your flight qualifies for early GoWild! access, call = +1 ☎ (US) or ✉ [{1 877_622_0707 } (USA) or ☎ {1 877_622_0707 } (USA) ✉ (US).

4. International Requirements to Consider Early

Booking the flight is only the first step. Because Frontier has strict "No Refund" policies for missed flights due to documentation errors, you should have these ready **at the time of booking**:

1. **Passport Validity:** Ensure your passport is valid for at least 6 months *after* your return date.
2. **Baggage:** International baggage fees are higher. Booking your bags at the same time you book your flight (3–5 months out) is the cheapest option.
3. **Check-In Time:** International travelers must check in at the airport counter at least **60 minutes** before departure for passport verification.

- [] **Monitor:** Start checking prices 6 months out.
- [] **Sweet Spot:** Aim to book between 90 and 150 days before takeoff.
- [] **Bundle:** If booking early, choose a "Bundle" to protect against price drops or schedule changes.
